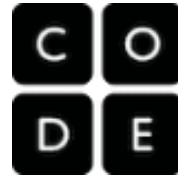

- ▶ Determine and implement appropriate K-12 computer science standards

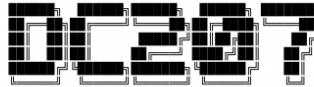
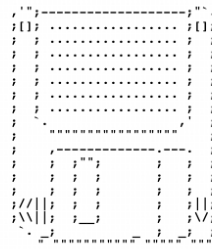
