MAINE’S LARGEST BUSINESS TECHNOLOGY SUMMIT AND TRADESHOW FEATURES TECHNOLOGY INNOVATORS, WORKSHOPS, EXHIBITORS

Portland, Maine – The Maine Technology Users Group (MTUG) celebrates its 35th year of tech events at the **2022 Information Technology Summit & Tradeshow on Thursday, May 26th 2022, 7:30am to 4pm**, at the Holiday Inn by the Bay, 88 Spring Street, Portland, Maine. An expected 400 IT professionals from Maine and New England will gather to share tech experiences and the latest in techniques, services and products.

Registration fee is \$55 “Early Rate” by 5/13, \$60 advanced purchase, and \$65 on the event day. Special rates available for technology students and active / retired military. Fee includes continental breakfast, boxed lunch, keynote, workshops, exhibit hall access, and afternoon refreshments. This year's Keynote Speaker is Bill Pierce, Chief Information Officer at The Jackson Laboratory, who will present **“Agility and Resilience in an age of Complexity”** harnessing his deep understanding of analytics, technologies, and organizations to help enlighten our path through increasingly complex and volatile times. Prior to his work with Jackson Labs, Mr. Pierce’s led the Platform Solutions team at PAREXEL and served as CIO in other clinical research organizations. He brings a background in financial services as well, building proprietary investment analytics, simulations, and risk models. He holds a patent from development of a B2B auction engine backed by eBay.

The event will feature 12 workshops covering tracks such as Security, IT Infrastructure, “Disruption,” and IT Workforce Development. Topics will include SDWAN, MS Defender and Endpoint security, custom IT Workforce education options in Maine, use of MITRE Tools in security, and many more. Workshops are led or co-led by “end-user” IT professionals at Maine-based organizations; sectors represented include retail, education, biotechnology, manufacturing, and more. MTUG’s workshops are hand-selected via a competitive RFP reviewed the nonprofit’s board of directors.

The exhibit hall of 50 vendor booths will be open all day, with ample time to visit between sessions. Exhibitors include representatives from IT and telecom infrastructure, IT services, technology consulting, and tech education vendors from Maine and across the nation.

The expected 400+ attendees will include IT and telecom professionals and senior business and operations managers from Maine and Northern New England, representing all sectors and industries, including finance, education, government, retail, manufacturing, construction, healthcare, nonprofit organizations and more. With three food events around the sessions, there will be plenty of time to network, share ideas, and ask questions of presenters and vendors.

The nonprofit Maine Technology Users Group (MTUG) invites IT professionals, managers, and technology enthusiasts from all industries and sectors to the 2022 Information Technology Summit and Tradeshow on Thursday, May 26th, 7:30am-4pm, at the Holiday Inn by the Bay, 88 Spring Street, Portland, Maine.

The MTUG IT Summit is Maine's largest business technology conference with 12 educational sessions, 50 vendor booths, and ample time to explore a broad range of IT topics, products, and services.

Workshop tracks include Security, IT Infrastructure, “Disruption”, and IT Workforce Development.
